CONDITIONS

1. The Tournament will be played under the Laws of the English Bowling Association.
2. The administration of the Tournament shall be carried out by the representative of the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk together with the Tournament Committee.
3. All matters affecting play on the greens shall be determined by the Senior Umpire and his colleagues, save that in case of wet weather, the Green Secretary in conjunction with the Green Steward shall be the sole judge of whether any green is playable and be empowered to postpone or regulate play.
4. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter venues/times for matches to be played after the 1st round match.
5. Pairs - 21 ends; Triples - 18 ends; Singles - 21 up.
6. In the Pairs and Triples competition, players taking part in the first game shall constitute the Team and should normally play together throughout the Competition. After the first game, one additional and the same player may, however, be used as a substitute at any time providing he has not already played in that particular event. No player will be allowed to scratch an entry to participate in another. All teams must include a named player from the programme entry in the first game.
7. If a competitor fails to report within 15 minutes of the time appointed, his opponent may be declared the winner, except that in the case of a player being unavoidable delayed in a previous game, the Committee reserves the right to grant a further extension.
8. The official score cards, signed by both skips in the Pairs/Triples, must be returned to the Green Secretary immediately after the conclusion of each game.
9. Games should be completed in the following times:- 3 hours. If it is obvious that players are not doing their best to complete in the specified time, the Green Secretary and Umpire, may determine the game after giving the players reasonable warning of their intention.
10. All players should wear white above the waist and greys up to the quarter finals. Semi finals and finals should, if possible, be played entirely in whites. Bowling shoes should be smooth soled, heelless and brown, grey or white in colour. Semi Final and Final day and times will be displayed on venue notice boards.
11. All bowls used during the Tournament must bear the B.I.B.C. or I.B.B. stamp which must be clearly visible dated 1985 or later (1989 or later if non composition bowls).
12. Subject to payment of the appropriate fee, this year's winners will be automatically entered for next years tournament.

There will be a major trophy for each event to be retained for one year and commemorative trophies for the winners which may be kept. There will also be prize money for each event, details to be announced.

All major trophies will be insured by the Tournament Committee but the winners will be required to keep the cups under conditions covered by the insurance policy.

Cups must be carefully packed and safely returned, carriage paid, to Oasis Leisure Centre, Seagate, Hunstanton PE36 5BD, at least 28 days before the commencing date of the next tournament.

NOTE
It would help the organisers very much during the Tournament if players would leave a telephone number or some means whereby they can be contacted fairly quickly to be informed of the times and places of play etc.
